

Constitution and Bylaws of the Deubrook Air Rifle Club

As of October 10th, 2024

Article I

Section 1 - This organization shall be known as the Deubrook Air Rifle Club.

Section 2 – The purpose of this organization shall be to teach firearms safety and develop marksmanship for the purpose of air rifle and pistol competition.

Section 3 – This constitution governs and sets forth the regulations for all club members. This constitution will be posted online at the club’s website.

Article II

Section 1 - Any Deubrook student, in grades seven through twelve, is eligible for regular membership. Students in grades seven through twelve from other schools may be invited at the discretion of the coach.

Section 2 – Regular members shall abide by Deubrook eligibility requirements.

Section 3 – Regular members in, the twelfth grade, that graduate prior to the conclusion of scheduled events which they are eligible for, or have qualified for, are permitted to complete the season as regular members of the club.

Section 4 – Parents, or guardians, of members in good standing, as well as other responsible adults that express interest, shall be eligible for associate membership. Associate members shall be eligible to participate (as space permits) in practice and appropriate postal matches, such as the Civilian Marksmanship Program’s Aces postal which is open to adult as well as junior shooters.

Article III

Section 1 – Decisions regarding major fund raising, equipment acquisition and similar matters shall be made by the coach/advisor with the advice of the board of directors, when appropriate. The coach, and any assistant coach(s), shall be responsible for decisions regarding the day-to-day operation of the club.

Section 2 – There shall be an annual meeting of the board of directors; special meetings may be called as needed by the directors.

Article IV

Section 1 – The club must have an insurance policy covering all club members and activities. The cost of the insurance will come out of the club account.

Section 2 - The club advisor will be responsible for securing adequate insurance.

Section 3 - This policy must be in place before any air rifles are fired each year.

Article V

Section 1 – No regular member of the club will be required to purchase any major equipment or air rifle to participate. However, the use of personally owned air rifles or equipment is NOT prohibited. Any personally owned air rifles, air pistols or equipment must be legal for the competition that the club is participating in as governed by the National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules or other governing

body. Associate members may be asked to cover costs related to match entry fees and supplies such as targets and pellets.

Article VI

Section 1 – The primary competitions that the club will participate in will be postal matches.

Section 2 – There may be some shoulder-to-shoulder matches in which the club will be eligible to participate. Team selection and travel arrangements for these will be handled on a case-by-case basis.

Article VII

Section 1 – Any gross violations of safety procedures, theft, misuse, or intentional damage to club equipment shall be grounds for immediate dismissal from the club.

Article VIII

Section 1 – The articles of this constitution may be amended, revised, or altered by 2/3 vote of the board of directors.
